PALS volunteer pilots donate their time, resources, and aircraft. Aircraft used by PALS pilots are typically non-pressurized, single engine, 4-6 seaters.

PALS pilots donate an average of 3 to 5 flights per year, but every single flight makes a tremendous difference.

Volunteer Pilot Basic Requirements:

- SE 350hrs PIC, 50hrs make and model; ME or Turbine 500hrs PIC, 50hrs make and model
- Access to an aircraft
- IFR rating

Pilots that do not meet the basic requirements may still serve as copilots/mission assistants.
